Meeting Highlights

### Welcome (Jennifer Robsinson, President)

- Many thank yous from past and present parents to Mr. Jones as he retires this month.
- STEM celebration is Nov. 27th at 9 am- all PTA members are invited to attend.
  - Looking to see if we can put anything outside the school to show it is a STEM certified school, and continues to recertify each year. Mention to superintendent.
- Holiday Shop is the second biggest fundraiser and will be in Dec. Committee chairs will need lots of parent volunteers- help with set up/clean up, helping students shop, etc.

### Mr. Jones Report

- Transition with Mr. Wilson is going great.
- STEM Certification Ceremony will be on Nov. 27th and will be live streamed as the school receives it recertification as a STEM school. County and State Superintendents will be in attendance as well as past and present students speaking about how important STEM is.
- Holiday Shop is coming up soon in Dec.
